Club Guidelines and Rules Following COVID-19 (Updated 19th July 2021)

In light of the current health crisis we have had to implement some additional temporary club rules to allow for us to safely reopen and play the games we all enjoy. While many of the original restrictions have been relaxed, we still ask members and visitors to adhere to the rules outlined in this document.

These changes are for your safety, if you are unable to follow these changes you may be asked to leave the premises for that week. Repeated issues may result in a longer or permanent ban as per the club rules.

Your Responsibilities

- **You must NOT attend**, if you show any symptoms of COVID-19 or have had close contact with a confirmed positive case of COVID-19 where you would be obligated to self-isolate.
- While **Face coverings/masks** are no longer a legal requirement, we encourage all to consider wearing them inside during busy periods.
- **Please consider washing or sanitising your hands** on entering and exiting the building.
- If you smoke or vape, **you must do so** away from both the building and the main entrance ramp.
- **You must** sign the register on arrival
- **You are encouraged to** check-in by scanning the QR code using the NHS Track and Trace app although there is now no obligation to do so.

Use of Kitchen and Utensils

Club refreshments such as tea and coffee will be available and you may consume food and drink. The kitchen is available for use, however the following rules apply to its usage:

- We advise that cups or cutlery from the hall are not used and recommend that you bring your own if required.

- You are required to wash, dry and put away any used items from the kitchen immediately when finished with them.
- Please take used food and drinks packaging and waste with you when you leave. The hall has no waste collection.

Hall Layout

- There is no longer any predetermined hall layout with exception to where particular types of games should be played for space reasons. E.g. Only tabletop games should be played in the main hall. Members and visitors will be expected to set up and pack away tables and terrain sensibly themselves from now on.
- Doors will be left open to increase ventilation. This may result in the hall getting colder than normal, so please plan accordingly.

Games

Tabletop games as well as role play, card and board games are now permitted at the club.

- As Warhammer 40,000 is the most popular game played at the club, a random draw for game pairings will be done on Wednesday evenings following a post on the club's Facebook group the previous Sunday or Monday asking who wishes to be included in the draw. The results of the random draw are added to the Facebook post. All random draw games are made with the following previsions, unless you agree with your drawn opponent otherwise:
 - 1 vs. 1 game with **2000 points** per army.
 - Casual/fun/narrative games with **no competitive/tournament lists**.
- If you are seeking a competitive or tournament type game, we strongly encourage you to arrange such games directly with another person.
- Showing on the night with no game arranged is welcome, **but we cannot guarantee** you can be accommodated as this will depend on player and space availability. Space will be available for random draw games.
- Payment for games as normal on the night but must be done so when signing in on entry to the building.

- Please **only play if you are committed to doing so**. If there is a pattern of individuals cancelling at the last minute for whatever reason, they may not be able to arrange games or be included in random draws going forward.
- Please tidy up after yourself and wipe down the table itself and chair handles (if applicable) using a wipe or spray before putting away.


